IGNITE is where *disciples are made and leaders are raised...*

It is a journey for men and women of all ages and backgrounds who have a passion to encounter the love of God, grow in their relationship with Him, and be equipped and empowered to impact their world with the good news of Jesus.

IGNITE is built on 3 pillars:

Who is God?

Who am I?

What am I called to?

The curriculum consists of 6 modules:

The Story of God

The Nature of God

Identity & Calling

The Life of a Disciple

Impact Your World

Re-writing the Story

IGNITE, however, is more than a course. It is a journey where people are ignited. It is all about encounter – encountering God in worship, encountering God in His word, encountering God in one another, and encountering God as we give away what we have learned.

The Programme – Newcastle is the first Methodist District to provide the **IGNITE** course, as part of the national partnership between the Methodist Church and the Pioneer Network of Churches. From 2014-2016, the course was held in Jesmond, Newcastle. For the past couple of years, the **IGNITE** programme has taken place on a Tuesday evening at Prudhoe Methodist Church. **IGNITE** at Haydon Bridge is the first time the programme will be held in the day time. **IGNITE** runs over three terms, with a break during the school half terms, finishing in early July.

The programme looks something like this:

12.00-12.30pm	Bring a packed lunch, tea and coffee provided
12.30-12.50pm	Worship session
12.50-1.30pm	Session 1
1.30-1.50pm	Group discussion
1.50-2.30pm	Session 2
2.30-2.45pm	Ministry time

Course Fees – the cost of the course is £250 for the whole year (payment by regular instalments available)

Travel – the fees do not include the costs of any travel, books, additional courses or conferences.

Groups and Mentoring – each student is put into a group which meets during the training. Students have the opportunity to be assigned a mentor whom they can meet with once or twice each term. The purpose of mentoring is to reflect on and apply what is being learnt.
