It's essential to Christian living that we develop our relationship with God through Jesus Christ, and that we grow to maturity in our discipleship.

At our meeting in April I should like us to have some discussion about how we, as preachers, leaders of worship and readers, equip members of our congregations for the work of ministry (cf. Ephesians 4: 11-13) – how we might inspire and empower people to grow into maturity and take responsibility for their own discipleship, worship, service and witness in the world, so that when the difficult times come they are able not just to stand firm but to grow.
